

Bonnyville Agricultural Society Scholarship

AWARD IS FOR \$2000.00

STIPULATIONS:

They must be registered full-time in a post-secondary program in the area of agricultural business.

Previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible for a second award. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of (not necessarily placed in order of importance): academic achievement, participation in: 4H, Bonnyville Agricultural Society, and/or other agricultural related areas as well as community work.

Candidates must supply at least two letters of recommendation, one preferably from their school, principle, or teacher and the other from a community involvement group leader.

Selection will be made by a Committee as established by the Bonnyville Agricultural Society. The Selection Committee considers a number of factors when selecting scholarship recipients: agricultural experience, a student's goals, financial need, involvement in community organizations, and academic achievement.

Scholarship monies are to be used to pay for tuition, books, fees, supplies, and accommodation expenses.

The successful recipient of the award must agree to have their name and their photograph published.

Applications must be received no later than June 30th of the year and selection will be announced by August 1 of the year.

Award will be presented in September of the year awarded and proof of enrolment in the Agriculturally related area of study is required before disbursement of funds.
